

ABOUT TAVERNE GUTENBERG



Taverne Gutenberg is a creative hub created by **Maïa d'Aboville** (interactive designer)
& **Henri Lamy** (international artist) in September 2015. What used to be an abandoned three storey-high apartment building is now transformed into a space of **creative exchanges and encounters**. It is located in the city-center of Lyon (second biggest city of France).

Since September, the team has quickly grown and now counts **17 000 members**, over **400 participating artists**, **15 resident artists** and a team of young volunteers, passionate about making a difference through **art and culture**.

OVERVIEW

The French art center «<u>Taverne Gutenberg</u>» will bring four **international visual artists** from Lyon (France) to Manila, more specifically to Poblacion (Makati) where they will be offered accommodation and a working space open to the public by main sponsor Z Hostel. The artists will **work together** with several **local partner groups** involved with **street-children** (NGOs, foundations & museums such as <u>Project Pearls</u>, <u>Museo Pambata</u> & <u>Stairway Foundation</u>).

The artists' mission will be **to promote and share art** to make it accessible to Filipinos, more specifically **street-children**. Furthermore, this project aims to **reinforce ties between France and Philippines** and marks the 70th anniversary of diplomatic relations. From painting monumental outdoor murals, collaborative murals, to giving out free art workshops and working in public spaces.

An important part of the project will be the **20-minute documentary** which will be a collaboration between French film director Simon Dubreucq & Filipino Media Production Company Sine de Oro.

Duration & dates: 8 weeks, from October to November 2017

Location: Poblacion (Makati, Philippines), Intramuros (Manila) & Puerto Galera (Or. Mindoro)




